#### **April 29, 2025**

**WHEREAS**, the Orange Board of Education Public School District received its State Aid notification on February 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the District has prepared a budget for FY 2025-2026 totaling \$166,264,632; and

**WHEREAS**, the FY 2025-2026 budget includes a \$388,225 debt service and \$13,023,999 tax levy, which has remained flat from the FY 2024-2025. State Aids increased by \$7,157,072; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 18A:21-3, NJSA 18A:7G-31 and NJSA 18A: 7F-41 permits a Board of Education to establish and/or deposit into certain reserve accounts at year end; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned statutes authorized procedures, under the authority of the Commissioner of Education, which permit a Board of Education to transfer unanticipated excess current revenue or unexpected appropriations into reserve accounts during the month of June by Board resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Orange Board of Education wishes to transfer unanticipated excess current year revenue or unexpended appropriations from the general fund into a Capital Reserve account at the yearend; and

WHEREAS, the Orange Board of Education has determined that an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000

WHEREAS, the Orange Board of Education wishes to transfer unanticipated excess current year revenue or unexpended appropriations from the general fund into a Maintenance Reserve account at the yearend; and

WHEREAS, the Orange Board of Education has determined that an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Orange Board of Education that it herby authorizes the district's Business Administrator/Board Secretary to make this transfer consistent with all applicable laws and regulations.

WHEREAS, the Tentative FY 2025-2026 budget includes \$240,451 for travel expenses and \$4,325,785 for professional development which shall be set, at this time, as the maximum allowed expenditures for these categories. The only change to the maximum tolerance set shall be as the result of any additional special revenue grants received that include travel and professional development as an approved activity; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education authorizes an annual maximum amount of \$1,500 per employee for business travel only for which district Board of Education approval is not required.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Orange Board of Education, accepts and approves the Orange Public Schools FY 2025-2026 budget in the amount of \$166,264,632.
