Sixteen of the Forty-Two students (38%) enrolled in the Essex County College (ECC) Dual Enrollment Associates Degree Program are CTE Students!

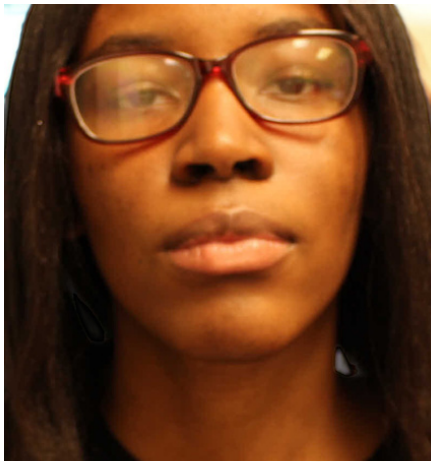

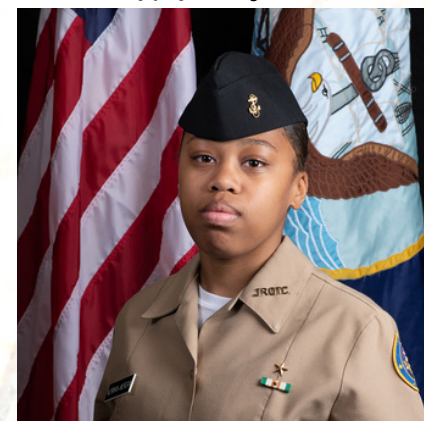
